PRESSING ON WITH PASTOR DEB

Sometimes renewal begins in the smallest, quietest ways. The other morning, as I was picking up twigs in the yard, I noticed something I must have passed a hundred times without seeing: a tiny sprout pushing its way up beside the fence. The ground still looked cold and tired from winter, but there

it was, new life, insisting on being born. It wasn't big or dramatic. Just a little sign that something was happening beneath the surface long before I ever noticed it. It made me think of Isaiah's words: "See, I am doing a new thing... now it springs up; do you not perceive it?" (Isaiah 43:19).

Sometimes renewal in our lives looks a lot like that little sprout, quiet, patient, sometimes hidden. Lent gives us the space to notice it. The slower pace, the reflective prayers, the small acts of kindness, they make room for God to stir something new in us.

As I think about our church family, I see those signs of new growth everywhere. In the person who shows up when the week has been hard. In the volunteer who steps into a ministry they never imagined themselves doing. In the gentle healing happening in hearts that have carried heavy loads. None of these moments shout for attention. They're small faithful steps, sprouts of grace breaking through.

Maybe that's how God renews us most often, not all at once, but little by little, in ways that surprise us when we finally stop long enough to see them. As we come nearer to Holy Week, I invite you to pay attention to the quiet places in your life where something new may be forming.



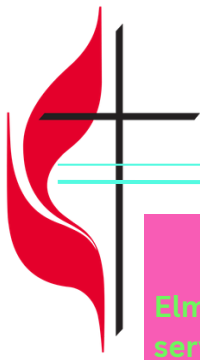
